Asper Foundation recognizes Levy with plaque of distinction

The Asper Foundation has recognized Hamilton-based activist and human-rights educator Madeleine Levy as an outstanding supporter of human rights and Holocaust education.

The honour was presented to Levy on Sunday at Temple Anshe Sholom in Hamilton, and marked just the third time that The Asper Foundation has awarded this plaque of distinction, which is personally signed by foundation president Gail Asper.

Levy is the program chair of The Asper Foundation Human Rights and Holocaust Education Program in the Hamilton region, leading a team that delivers the human-rights education programs to students in several Ontario communities. In 2008, Levy was named the Royal Bank Hamilton Distinguished Citizen of the Year.
