

The Asper Foundation Human Rights and Holocaust Studies Program

The 2016-2017 Asper Foundation Human Rights and Holocaust Studies Program includes two separate trips in the fall of 2016 and spring of 2017 to Winnipeg, MB comprised of 285 students and chaperones from the three communities and three schools/community organizations noted below.

On October 7, 2014, the Canadian Museum for Human Rights and The Asper Foundation signed a memorandum of understanding which is now seeing Canadian students switch the travel destination from Washington, DC to Winnipeg, MB including a visit to the Canadian Museum for Human Rights as part of the foundation's program.

A program trip with The Anne and Max Tanenbaum Community Hebrew Academy of Toronto took place on September 25-28, 2016. A national trip will take place on April 30-May 3, 2017.
