

The Asper Foundation Human Rights and Holocaust Studies Program

There are two separate program trips to Winnipeg, MB in the fall of 2016 and spring of 2017 with 285 students and chaperones from three communities and three schools/community organizations in three provinces.

On October 7, 2014, the Canadian Museum for Human Rights and The Asper Foundation signed a memorandum of understanding which is now seeing Canadian students switch the travel destination from Washington, DC to Winnipeg, MB including a visit to the Canadian Museum for Human Rights as part of the Foundation's program.

A program trip with The Anne and Max Tanenbaum Community Hebrew Academy of Toronto took place on September 25-28, 2016. A national trip will take place on April 30 – May 3, 2017 with students and chaperones from the Atlantic Jewish Council in Halifax, Nova Scotia and École Sainte-Anne in Fredericton, New Brunswick.
